- From the new Boardwalk you will have perfect views of Robben Island.
- There are an estimated 61 Cape Fur Seals.
- The Cape Wheel is over 50m high.
- Over 37 species of whales and dolphins visit the SA coastline. You might just spot one of these beautiful creatures.
- Beautiful views of Table Mountain - one of the Seven Wonders of Nature.

INTERESTING FACTS

- The V&A Waterfront is the most visited destination in South Africa [over 23 million visitors annually].
- The V&A Waterfront property is the size of about 180 rugby fields.
- The Cape Town Stadium is only 10 minutes walk away.
